Second Annual Kate Besser Memorial Lecture Pays Tribute to Tony Hillerman

This year's Second Annual Kate Besser Memorial Lecture features a tribute to the life and work of the famed detective novelist and non-fiction author Tony Hillerman. The event takes place at 7 p.m., Tuesday, Sept. 22. SFCC has teamed up with the New York City-based Symphony Space, an award-winning performing arts program responsible for the nationally broadcast public radio program "Selected Shorts," a series of storytelling performance read by stars of the stage and screen.

Melding the art of performance and storytelling, actors Wesley "Wes" Studi ("Dances With Wolves," "Last of the Mohicans" and a series of PBS movies based on Hillerman novels) and Kate Burton ("Grey's Anatomy," "Alice in Wonderland" and numerous Broadway stage productions) will perform selections from famed Hillerman works such as "A Time Thief," "Skinwalkers" and "The Great Taos Bank Robbery." The event takes place at the Lensic Performing Arts Center; tickets are \$10.
