The AAA in Photography degree prepares students for entry level work in areas such as, advertising, editorial, and fine arts photography. The program includes digital, silver, and non-silver techniques, as well as, conceptual and expressive approaches to using photography as a means of communication. Students develop an understanding of historical, cultural, and aesthetic perspectives in photography in addition to learning how to critically analyze an image. The program of study includes an internship component and business courses in order to build practical marketplace skills. Students complete their studies by creating a portfolio of their work of sufficient quality to obtain work in photography and launch a freelance business.

The AAA and AAS degree are designed to prepare students for entry level positions in specific occupations. The AAA and AAS are not generally intended to transfer to four year colleges or universities. Students should select all SFCC courses in consultation with an advisor. In addition, students should speak with an SFCC advisor if planning to transfer.
