**Eligibility Requirements for GED<sup>®</sup> Testing**

The minimum age is to take the GED<sup>®</sup> exam is **16 years old**. International students must be at least 17. Individuals under the age of 18 are required to submit a completed Underage Verification Form (available at the Testing Center) signed by a parent or guardian and by the Superintendent of the examinee's local school district. The completed form must include the examinee's New Mexico nine-digit state student ID number. This form must be submitted at the time of registration.

**Registering to Take the GED<sup>®</sup> at SFCC**

**WEDNESDAY test dates:** Registration is on a first-come, first-served same-day basis, and seating is limited. To register, come to the Testing Center on the day of the test between 8:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.

**\*\*MONDAY test dates:** Registration is on a pre-registration basis, and seating is limited. To register, come to the Testing Center anytime before the day of the test during regular center hours (8:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. on Monday-Thursday; 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. on Friday) or on the day of the test between 8:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Candidates who pre-register then fail to show for a scheduled exam will be subject to a \$20 rescheduling fee.

**Registration must be completed IN PERSON at the testing center BY THE EXAMINEE ONLY.** All GED<sup>®</sup> candidates must present an acceptable form of identification at the time of registration AND at the time of testing. The identification must be a current (non-expired) government-issued photo ID that indicates name, date of birth, address and signature (e.g., driver's license, state-issued ID card, U.S. passport).

At the time of registration, examinees must submit a payment receipt from the SFCC Cashier's Office for each of the GED<sup>®</sup> tests they intend to take (\$20 per test). Payment may be made by cash, check or credit card. Examinees under the age of 18 must also submit a completed Underage Verification Form (see Eligibility Requirements above).

**Accommodations for Documented Disabilities**

The GED<sup>®</sup> allows for special testing accommodations for those examinees who qualify under the Americans with Disabilities Act. Permission for accommodations must be given from the New Mexico State GED<sup>®</sup> Administrator, but the process for receiving accommodations begins with the local Testing Center. Please speak with one of the GED<sup>®</sup> examiners in the SFCC Testing Center for more information.
