

# Calculating Your Bill

The Total cost of a class is determined by adding:

Tuition + Service Fee + SGA Fee + Additional Course/Program Fee (as noted in the class listing)

## In-state and in-district resident

Regular rate     \$34 per credit hour

Early bird rate \$30 per credit hour

If you have established New Mexico residency for tuition purposes\* and reside within the college's taxing district.\*\*

## In-state but out-of-district resident

Regular rate     \$45 per credit hour

Early bird rate \$41 per credit hour

If you have established New Mexico residency for tuition purposes\* and reside outside the college's taxing district.\*\*

## Out-of-state resident

Regular rate     \$81 per credit hour

Early bird rate \$73 per credit hour

If you are taking more than six credits per semester and have not established New Mexico residency for tuition purposes.\* If you are an out-of-state resident taking six or fewer credits per semester, your tuition is based on in-state, out-of-district residency.

## Senior citizens

\$5 per credit hour

If you are 65 or older and have established New Mexico residency for tuition purposes\* and are enrolled for six or fewer credits per semester. Applies on a space-available basis. If you are taking more than six credits per semester, state law requires that you be charged the applicable full rate for ALL credits.

## Armed forces

Members of the U.S. armed forces, their spouses and dependent children, and members of the armed forces of a foreign country assigned to active duty in New Mexico may qualify for in-state rates.

\*Minimum residency for in-state tuition rates is 12 consecutive months. If you moved here from another state, your residency status for tuition purposes does not change automatically – you must submit an in-state residency application and provide proof you have established residency to Enrollment and Student Services by Census Day. For information, call (505) 428-1270.

\*\* The college's taxing district matches the Santa Fe Public School District. In addition to Santa Fe, it includes Glorieta, Madrid, Cerrillos, Lamy, La Cienega, Galisteo and Tesuque.
