How much will this program cost me?

Tuition and Fees:	\$930.30

What are my Financing options to pay for the program?

In addition to any grant and scholarship aid that students received, 53% of graduates used loans to help finance their education. The median debt for program graduates is shown below:

How long will it take me to complete this program?

The certificate is designed to be completed within 2 years. Your actual time could be longer if you choose to take one class at a time. In the most recent year, 60.5% of graduates in this program completed it within 2 years.

What are my chances of finding a job when I graduate?

Although we don't have specific job placement data available for graduates of this program, overall, graduates from SFCC have a placement rate of 65%.
