A degree in gallery management prepares the student for employment in art galleries and museums. Through coursework and field experience, students are provided a comprehensive knowledge of gallery design, sales, marketing, art law, web applications and object care and handling.

Through the Gallery Management Internship program students will gain invaluable knowledge of the inner workings of galleries & museums and of career choices in the arts. Students work under the supervision and mentorship of professional art historians, curators, conservators, archivists, and gallery directors. Tasks and skills learned may include collections management, sales, administration and office assistance, publicity, artist promotion, exhibition installation, docent training, assistance with education programs or special events, curatorial research, gallery procedures, inventory, and marketing.
