With a two-year degree in Early Childhood Education (ECE) students could pursue the following occupations:

Lead Teacher in an early education setting (0-5yr)

Educational Assistant in a public school classroom

Administrator in a Head Start program

Center Director for a community early childhood program

Program Director for Head Start
Camp and Recreational
Coordinator

Students can transfer to a 4-year institution and obtain a bachelor's degree in education to teach as a public school teacher in Early Childhood Education (K-3).

This degree is intended to transfer to a university.

- Understanding professionalism based on individual integrity, responsibility and ethical practices
- Understanding assessment of children and evaluation of programs
