Santa Fe, NM, Wednesday, Oct. 21, 2009 — Santa Fe residents struggling with debt and foreclosure can receive free information from licensed attorneys, 10 a.m. to noon, Saturday, Oct. 31, at Santa Fe Community College, 6401 Richards Ave. Individuals behind on credit card bills, under pressure from debt collectors or faced with the possibility of home foreclosure will benefit from the event. The session takes place in SFCC classrooms 219, 220 and 221 – located on the west wing of the college’s main campus. The event is offered by the First Judicial District Pro Bono Committee, local attorneys and the SFCC School of Business and Applied Technologies, and is held in conjunction with “National Pro Bono Week,” a celebration highlighting the importance of equal access to justice for citizens.
