SANTA FE, NM – One hundred of the region's finest artists and craftspeople from across the state will gather to sell their creations during Santa Fe Community College's Holiday Arts and Crafts Fair, to be held 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, December 3 in the Main Hallway at SFCC, 6401 Richards Ave. Admission and parking are free.

Artists from Velarde, Corrales, Cochiti, Santo Domingo, Taos, Rio Rancho, Albuquerque, Farmington and Santa Fe are participating in the event. A gamut of styles and materials will be represented, from silver work to baked goods, woven handbags to woodcarvings, knitting to quilting, pottery to painting, jewelry, tin work, handmade cards and ornaments and much more.

One of the artists, Holly Stults, helped establish the metals arts program at SFCC in 1999; she taught jewelry there for four years.
