SFCC to Close Monday, Jan. 16, 2012 in Honor of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

SANTA FE, NM –Santa Fe Community College will close Monday, Jan. 16, in honor of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. All campus facilities will be closed except the [Early Childhood Development Center](#), [KSFR 101.1 FM Santa Fe Public Radio](#) and [La Familia Dental Clinic](#). No classes or activities will be held and no other student services will be available. The campus will reopen on Tuesday, January 17. Spring Semester classes begin Monday, January 23.
