Art of Fashion Show Showcases SFCC Student Designers

Santa Fe, NM— Students from Santa Fe Community College’s Fashion Design Program are the centerpiece of the forthcoming “Art of Fashion Show,” to be held Thursday, March 25, at The Lodge at Santa Fe, 750 N. St. Francis Drive. A cocktail reception starts at 6:30 p.m., followed by a fashion show of original student designs at 7:30 p.m. The runway show will feature the original work of seven aspiring SFCC fashionistas. The evening will also feature performances by local DJs, as well as art, jewelry and fashion displays.

The showcase is sponsored by BuzzNetworkingABQ, a social and business networking company based in Albuquerque that hosts monthly fashion show events. Fashion Club SFCC was formed by devoted students of the college’s Fashion Design Program. SFCC is the only public college in New Mexico to offer a certificate in fashion design and attracts students from throughout the state, according to program head, Mechele Hesbrook. Students in the fashion design program can take courses in fashion illustration, computer-aided design, fashion design history, pattern making, garment construction and textiles. In addition, students learn to set up fashion design businesses from concept to creation.

The event is open to those 21 years and older. General admission is \$10; \$5 with SFCC student identification.
