SANTA FE, NM – Santa Fe Community College will close for Thanksgiving holiday Thursday through Sunday, November 24-27. All campus facilities will be closed. No classes or activities will be held and no other student services will be available. The campus will reopen on Monday, November 28.

The community college will also be closed during Winter Break from Saturday, Dec. 17 through Monday, Jan. 2. The college will reopen on Tuesday morning, Jan. 3.
