Of Note: The Santa Fe Higher Education Center is a partnership among SFCC, New Mexico Highlands University, the Institute of American Indian Arts and the University of New Mexico to increase access to higher education. The center provides a single location where students can earn a bachelor's or master's degree – without leaving Santa Fe and at a price that is affordable. The pilot program on the SFCC campus offers bachelor's-level classes in business administration, criminal justice, early childhood education, human services, teacher education and indigenous studies, among others. By attending SFCC for two years before transferring to a four-year college, students can save as much as \$10,000. Registration for the spring semester begins November 14.
