THE SUPERCOMPUTER ROLLS OUT TO SITES ACROSS THE STATE

FASTEST PUBLIC COMPUTER IN THE WORLD BRINGS
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL TO NM

SANTA FE – The State's Supercomputing Center (which runs the fastest publicly available supercomputer in the world) will open the first eight Gateway access sites around the state and network them all together in a launch event called “Connect New Mexico.”

Gov. Bill Richardson will host the event, which will tie Santa Fe Community College and seven other Gateway sites together through teleconferencing and full 3-dimensional stereo visualization systems. The event will include cabinet members, legislators, business leaders, presidents of colleges and universities, and others. These Gateway sites will bring the Supercomputer and its partners to all corners of the state.

The Supercomputing Center is making good on its promise to be a driver for economic development, education, and workforce development. A presentation at the event, sent statewide, will showcase the remarkable opportunities the Supercomputing Center is making possible.
