Brazilian Biodiesel Expert Gives Free Lecture at SFCC

Santa Fe, NM, Sept. 3, 2009 — On Sept. 9, Brazilian biodiesel expert, entrepreneur and professor Miguel Dabdoub presents a lecture titled “Biofuels, Environment, Food and Hunger,” from 2:30 to 5 p.m., Sept. 9, inside the SFCC Board Room, located on the SFCC campus, 6401 Richards Ave., Santa Fe. The lecture will cover the evolving biofuels energy industry and its impact on people and the environment. Dabdoub holds a doctorate in organic chemistry and has more than 20 years in biodiesel research, development and instruction at São Paulo University. He is also President and CEO of Biodiesel Brasil USA, which has constructed 13 biodiesel factories worldwide, including two in the U.S. Dabdoub is currently expanding his biodiesel operations into Santa Fe.
