An Associates Degree in Professional Crafts provides students with skills in one of the three disciplines of Fine Woodworking, Ceramics or Jewelry.

Entrepreneurial, design, and fabrication skills prepare the graduate for beginning a career as a professional artisan.

Students will produce a body of work that represents a coherent and unique personal style for presentation to a prospective employer.

Students develop highly refined skills to create one-of-a-kind functional and non-functional objects. They will conclude their studies by building a portfolio of fine art crafts that will lead to employment or the launch of their own individual business.

- The ability to design and fabricate objects that are competitive in the contemporary marketplace.
- Knowledge and ability necessary to set up a functioning studio.
- Awareness of demands of the contemporary marketplace.
- Presentation skills for entry into the professional world of fine arts crafts.
- Writing and communication skills necessary to clearly express the objectives and direction of one's art.
- Ability to target and negotiate contractual agreements with galleries, artists' representatives, and craft fair venues.
- A broad spectrum of aesthetic discernment.
