SFCC President Sheila Ortego Discusses CSF State Takeover

Santa Fe, NM, Dec. 5, 2008 — On Sunday, Dec. 7, at 5:30 p.m., Santa Fe Community College President, Sheila Ortego, discusses her perspective on the possibility of a state takeover of College of Santa Fe. The interview airs on “Campus Connection,” a 30-minute radio program focused on news and newsmakers from SFCC, on Santa Fe Public Radio, KSFR 101.1 FM.

Ortego recently pledged support for a possible state university takeover of CSF. She said increased coordination and cooperation between SFCC and a four-year university on the site of the CSF campus would be beneficial for the community. “We believe students and taxpayers will be well served by a model that emphasizes collaboration, uses taxpayer funding wisely and opens new doors of opportunity for area residents,” she said in a recent statement.

“Campus Connection” is hosted by SFCC director of media relations Todd Lovato. The program also airs on Thursday mornings at 9 a.m. on KSWV 810 AM.
