SFCC Dental Clinic Moves Off Campus

Santa Fe, NM, Jan. 6, 2009 — Santa Fe Community College’s Dental Clinic will resume operations from a new off-campus location, starting January 2009. The clinic, which serves as an educational laboratory for SFCC students and a low-cost dental health care center for the uninsured, will take up temporary residence at 6 Calle Medico, Suite 1, Santa Fe. “We want our patients and our community to be assured that, although the clinic is moving, it will continue serving Santa Feans the same way it did before the move,” said SFCC dental program director, Aamna Nayyar.

The clinic provides hands-on training to the college’s dental students and serves hundreds of low-income residents with free and low-cost dental care through partnerships with Project ANN and Medicaid, said Nayyar.

The clinic’s previous home, a portable building on the SFCC campus, is being removed to make room for the college’s new Health and Sciences Building, set to break ground Jan. 15, 2009. The Health and Sciences Building is slated for completion in spring 2010 and will house La Familia Medical Center, a local non-profit community dental health care provider that will partner with SFCC's dental program.

SFCC’s Dental Program includes a 10-month certificate in dental assisting and an Associate of Applied Science degree in dental health. For more information, call 428-1710.
