Candidates Established in SFCC Governing Board Election

Santa Fe, NM, Feb. 3, 2009 — Four candidates have filed for three seats on the Santa Fe Community College Governing Board. The election will be held March 3.

Two seats are uncontested. Current Board Chair Linda Siegle is running unopposed in position one and Chris Abeyta is running unopposed in position four.

Position two is a two-year seat that fulfills the unexpired term of former board member Margaret Garduno and is currently held by Heidi Tilton, new president of the GROW SFCC Foundation Board. Marcia Litzenberg and Andrea Bermudez are the candidates for that seat.

The board's five elected members serve on the SFCC Governing Board for overlapping six-year terms. The board plays an instrumental role in the success of the college by establishing policies and procedures and advancing the best interests of students, faculty, staff and greater community.

A candidate forum, sponsored by the League of Women Voters of Santa Fe County and the Santa Fe branch of the American Association of University Women, will be held at the college from 6 to 8 p.m., Thursday, February 19, in the Jemez Rooms, 6401 Richards Ave.
